Leave No Trace

Come see Sundance Winner and Academy Award nominee writer-director Debra Granik speak about her new film *Leave No Trace*, starring the exceptional Ben Foster and incandescent 17-year-old newcomer, Thomasin Harcourt McKenzie. *Leave No Trace* tells the emotional story of a father and daughter living dangerously off the grid in a way that is unnerving and uncompromising yet profoundly meaningful. Granik is best known for 2010's *Winter's Bone*, which starred Jennifer Lawrence in her breakout performance and for which Granik was nominated for Academy Awards for Best Picture and Best Adapted Screenplay. *Leave No Trace* is based on the book *My Abandonment* by Peter Rock.
