*** Placement Class REQUIRED**

Placement class (required *only* for DAN 319, 320, 419, 420) will be held in the **Hearst Dance Theater** on **Tuesday, September 10 at 3:00 p.m.** Faculty will make placement decisions and send email notifications by 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, September 11. At that point, you will be given permission to enroll in both your A and B sections.

DAN courses 319, 320, 419, 420 each have **two components**, and all students *must* enroll in **BOTH** an A section (Choreography Workshop I, II, III, or IV, meets Fridays) and a B section (Dance Performance Workshop: Repertory I, II, III, or IV, meets either Mondays/Wednesdays or Tuesdays).

Your course numbers for your A and B components might not be the same. Example: you may be placed in DAN**319A** (Choreography Workshop I), and in DAN**419B** (Dance Performance Workshop III). As *first year students*, you will most likely be placed in 319A. Please note that you **must** enroll in both an A and B section.

Important: students enrolled in these courses will perform in the *Princeton Dance Festival*, December 5-8, 2019. This is a *required* component of these courses.
